9 Points

For all problems in this section, you can use the following functions as given:

```
let rec map f xs = match xs with
| [] -> []
| x::xt -> (f x)::(map f xt)

let rec foldl f a xs = match xs with
| [] -> a
| x::xt -> foldl f (f a x) xt

let rec foldr f xs a = match xs with
| [] -> a
| x::xt -> f x (foldr f xt a)

let sum x = foldl (fun a x -> a + x) 0 x
let length x = foldl (fun a x -> a + 1) 0 x
let avg x = (sum x)/(length x)
```

First, write a function, first_k: ('a list -> int -> 'a list), that, given a list and a number k, returns the first k numbers in the list. If the length of the list is less than k, then it returns an empty list.

Examples:

```
first_k [1; 2; 3; 4] 2 = [1; 2]
first_k [1; 2; 3; 4] 5 = []
```

```
all_averages [[1; 2]; [2; 3]; [3; 4]] = [1; 2; 3]
```

let rec get_even lst = match lst with
| [] -> []
| h::t -> if h mod 2 = 0 then h::(get_even t) else (get_even t)
```
