- What is a software test adequacy criterion
 - Predicate that defines “what properties of a program must be exercised to constitute a thorough test”, i.e., one whose successful

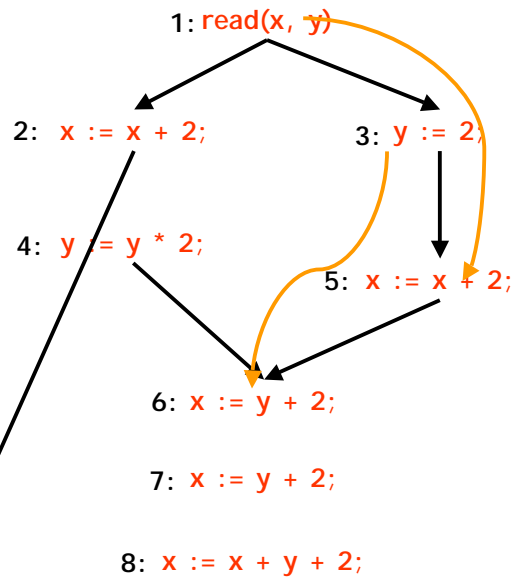
Structural Testing

- Program-based structural testing
 - Control-flow based adequacy criteria
 - Statement coverage
 - Branch coverage
 - Path coverage
 - Length-i path coverage
 - Cyclomatic number criterion
 - Set of v independent paths, where $v = e - n + 1$
 - Multiple condition coverage
 - All possible combinations of truth values of predicates
 - Data-flow based adequacy criteria

Structural Testing

- Data-flow based adequacy criteria
 - All definitions criterion
 - Each definition to some reachable use
 - All uses criterion
 - Definition to each reachable use
 - All def-use criterion
