O1: Technical Content	<p><u>Depth</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No reference to relevant literature, theories, or technical knowledge <p><u>Accuracy</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Presentation is thoroughly riddled with errors and inaccuracies Thoroughly unreliable as source of information 	<p><u>Depth</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explanation or application of theories or concepts are inaccurate or incomplete No attempt to tie theory to practice <p><u>Accuracy</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Knowledgeable listener is distracted by errors and inaccuracies Presentation might be useful if one could determine reliable info 	<p><u>Depth</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explns of concepts & applications of theory or concepts are accurate, only minor problems Some helpful examples are offered <p><u>Accuracy</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No significant errors. Any errors made are the result of nervousness or oversight 	<p><u>Depth</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Accurate & complete explanation of main concepts, and theories Applications included to illuminate issues and demonstrate real insight <p><u>Accuracy</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Information included is consistently accurate
O2: Organization & Structure	<p><u>Introduction</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Intro, if present, is brief Topic or purpose of talk is omitted <p><u>Body</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clearly unorganized, speaker rambles Difficult if not impossible to understand due to shifts in topic <p><u>Topic Development</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Supporting material, if present, is clearly insufficient and/or inappropriate <p><u>Conclusion</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Undeveloped, fails to summarize the talk, poorly connected to body of talk, etc. 	<p><u>Introduction</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduces topic but does not fully capture attention Purpose not clearly stated Abrupt shift to body <p><u>Body</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Main points, while present, are difficult to identify This lack of organization hinders understanding <p><u>Topic Development</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Some supporting material is inappropriate and/or significantly lacking in development <p><u>Conclusion</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Abrupt and /or inadequate summary of presentation 	<p><u>Introduction</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Captures attention Statement of purpose Explicit transition to body <p><u>Body</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Easy to follow but some points may not be completely clear and/or clearly prioritized Main ideas evident but organizational structure may need improvement <p><u>Topic Development</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Supporting material relevant but may be lacking in originality or some minor problems concerning adequate development <p><u>Conclusion</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Summarizes talk clearly Presents final thoughts or suggestions 	<p><u>Introduction</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Creatively captures attention Clear statement of purpose Smooth transition <p><u>Body</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Makes main points clear (e.g., defining a problem, methods for solving, results, etc.) Logically organized, fully prioritized, clear, and easy to understand <p><u>Topic Development</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pts. emphasized in proportion to import. Supporting material is original, logical, and relevant. <p><u>Conclusion</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Summarizes talk (e.g., relates result to the orig. problem) clearly and concisely Offers memorable final thought or message
O3 Multimedia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No aids are used or if used seriously detract from the message Aids, if used are of consistently poor quality (e.g., too much info, unimportant info highlighted, font too small, etc.) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Insufficient Most aids used are superfluous and/or distracting The aids are of inconsistent quality 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Multimedia aids are related to the content of presentation and generally enhance message Quality of aids are consistently good 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Creative, well integrated, and enhance the message High quality (vivid, simple, complete, easy to comprehend, minor or no errors, font size appropriate, details minimized to highlight main points, etc.)

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O4: Delivery & Presentation Skills	<u>Verbal</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No pacing or pace interferes w. undrstanding, mumbling, serious mispronunciations, and overall disjointed and/or monotonous pres. <u>Non-Verbal</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No eye contact Posture terrible and facial expressions inappropriate Gestures and movements excessive and seriously distracting Reading str. from notes 	<u>Verbal</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Uneven rate, unclear and/or trembling voice, mispronunciation of terms, and little or no expression <u>Non-Verbal</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Little or no eye contact Poor posture Inappropriate facial expressions Gestures and movements distracting Over dependence on notes 	<u>Verbal</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Steady pace, clear voice, minimal pronunciation problems, and stiff presentation or excessively rehearsed. <u>Non-Verbal</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Some effective eye contact Posture, facial expressions, gestures, and movements do not detract from the presentation 	<u>Verbal</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pace varies effectively to emphasize points, dynamic voice that enhances message, precise pronunciation of terms, fluid, confident. <u>Non-Verbal</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Good eye contact Posture and facial expressions indicate confidence/willingness to communicate Gestures and movements enhance overall presentations
O5: Presentation Length	<u>Time - Exceeded</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Significantly longer than allotted time Too much extraneous information and/or relevant topics overly developed given the time Excess use of time may also be due to delivery problems caused by little or no rehearsal <u>Time - Underutilized</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Significantly shorter Lacking much essential information for adequate topic development within the given time constraints. Again, problems may be due to lack of rehearsal, e.g. talking too fast. 	<u>Time - Exceeded</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Somewhat longer than allotted time Some extra information included and/or relevant topics developed a little beyond what is necessary Excess use of time may also be due to delivery problems resulting from lack of practice <u>Time - Underutilized</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Somewhat shorter Missing some essential information for adequate topic development within time constraints Alternatively, time problem may be due to lack of practice. 	<u>On-time</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Minor or no deviations from time limit Problems with over or underdevelopment of topic are minor Some minor, awkward or inappropriate manipulation of delivery to meet time constraints – Examples might include rushing the talk, skipping through slides, etc. 	<u>On-time</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Minor or no deviations from allotted time Topic is appropriately developed in a coherent fashion with essential, relevant information. No awkward manipulation of delivery to meet time constraints of the presentation
O6: Questions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Unable to answer even rudimentary questions 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Uncomfortable with information Only able to answer the most basic questions 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Comfortable control of content Able to provide some examples, elaboration, and explanations 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clear mastery Capable of answering all questions using appr. examples, explanations, and elaboration No distractions
