This quiz will function as a **mini-project**, designed to be completed in **50 minutes or less**. Similar to a regular project, you will:

- Download the starter files,
- Develop your solution,
- Submit your code to the Submit Server to check against the automated tests.

You may use **lecture slides**, **recorded videos**, and **class code samples**. However, this is an **individual assignment**:

- **Do not work with others.**
- **Do not use the web or AI services to find or generate code.**
