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Each reference is followed by one or more keywords. It is also followed by a list of the sections in which it is referenced. The format is “F”, “D”, or “A”, followed by the section number. “F” corresponds to this book, “D” corresponds to 1637, and “A” corresponds to 1636. “F.P”, “D.P”, and “A.P” denote the appropriate preface. “D.L” and “A.L” denote the corresponding appendices describing the pseudo-code language. The four appendices in this book are referenced by their corresponding one-letter label. “A” denotes the appendix describing the B-tree; “B” denotes the appendix describing linear hashing; “C” denotes the appendix describing spiral hashing; and “D” denotes the appendix describing the pseudo-code language. All references that are cited in the solutions to the exercises are associated with the section in which the exercise is found and are distinguished from the actual section that contains the exercise by the suffix “s”. The indexes in this book are referenced by the following two-letter labels. “X.K” denotes the Reference Keyword Index. “X.A” denotes the Author and Credit Index. “X.S” denotes the Subject Index. In the case of this book, additional details are available by providing the page numbers within parentheses following the section number.

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
