 - Client-server architectures: Distributed services which are called on by clients. Servers that provide services are treated differently from clients that use services.
 - Distributed-object architectures: No distinction between clients and servers. Any object on the system may provide and use services from other objects.
- 3. What are thin and fat clients?
 - Thin-client model: In a a thin-client model, all of the application processing and data management is carried out on the server. The client is simply responsible for running the presentation software.
 - Fat-client model: The server is only responsible for data management. The software on the client implements the application logic and the interactions with the system user.
