


The following diagrams show the prerequisite structure for most computer science courses.







*NOTES:

CMSC434: Do not requires PSYC100

CMSC427: Also has a prerequisite of MATH240 (Linear Algebra) or MATH461.

CMSC435: Prerequisite: 1 course from CMSC412, CMSC417, CMSC420, CMSC430, CMSC433

CMSC456: (CMSC330; CMSC351) or 2 MATH4xx

CMSC460 and CMSC466: Prerequisite: CMSC106 or CMSC131, MATH240, and MATH241

460 and 466 come up as duplicate credit at the university level. A student physically cannot take both.
